BCSD Celebrates Historic Graduation Rate!



The Georgia Department of Education officially released graduation rates for the Class of 2023, and there is a LOT to celebrate! The overall District graduation rate of 87.07% beat the state average, and all seven of our high schools saw improvement over their 2022 rates! The District's overall graduation rate has increased about 35 percentage points in the past decade, up from an overall District graduation rate of 52.3% in 2012. A standout for the District is Central High School, earning the District's highest ever graduation rate of 96.41% for the Class of 2023.




Central High School Marching Band Participates in Annual McDonald's Magic City Classic

District Continues Celebrations of Hispanic Heritage Month




