April 2019 - Begin Topic Selection Process

May - Narrow down Research Question

June-July - Research information begin Rough Draft

August - Pair with Advisor, Initial Meeting w/Supervisor

September - Rough Draft Due (Minimum 1500 Words)

October - November - Continue work on 2nd Draft of Extended Essay

December - 2nd Draft Due (3000 words)

January - Plagiarism Check/Final Draft Due (Max: 4000 words)

February - Viva Voce / Complete RPPF Form

Top 5 Biggest EE Mistakes

- 1) Putting off the EE until right before the deadlines
- 2) Choosing a topic that is too broad in scope
- 3) Choosing a topic which does not interest you
- 4) Not meeting with your supervisor and completing the reflections
- 5) Not citing where your information comes from.

Central IB (Rising Juniors)

▶ Diploma

- ▶ Takes full IB load of classes
- ▶ All benefits of IB
- ▶ Take all tests *
- ▶ IB Medallion and Seal Sr. Year
- ▶ Can get up to a year of college and scholarships

Defining terminology (specific to PDP)

- ▶ Probation
 - ▶ A student has had one incident of bad behavior or student has been academically dishonest.
 - ▶ Cheating
 - ▶ Plagiarism (Submitting work that is not your own and does not have sources)
 - ▶ Taking a picture of an exam
 - ▶ Copying homework
 - ▶ Student remains in program PDP as long as there are no more violations.

Defining terminology (PDP only)

▶ Removal (Dismissal)

- ▶ Student has had two or more incidents of bad behavior or academic dishonesty.
- ▶ Student fails a PDP class- students may do credit repair for grade, but does not remain in IB
- ▶ Student will not be in classes at the end of the year.
- ▶ Student if not in Central Zone goes back to home school. If in Central Zone the will be placed in Regular Classes and not IB or PDP for the next year.
- ▶ Letter will be sent to parent by certified mail explaining dismissal.
