Extended Essay Timeline (Juniors)

April - Begin Topic Selection Process

May - Narrow down Research Question

June-July - Research information begin Rough Draft

August - Pair with Advisor, Initial Meeting w/Supervisor

September - Rough Draft Due (Minimum 1500 Words)

October - November - Continue work on 2nd Draft of Extended Essay

December - 2nd Draft Due (3000 words)

January - Plagiarism Check/Final Draft Due (Max: 4000 words)

February - Viva Voce / Complete RPPF Form

Top 5 Biggest EE Mistakes

- 1) Putting off the EE until right before the deadlines
- 2) Choosing a topic that is too broad in scope
- 3) Choosing a topic which does not interest you
- 4) Not meeting with your supervisor and completing the reflections
- 5) Not citing where your information comes from.

Rigor

Increase the number of diplomas

Central IB

▶ Course

- ▶ One to four classes
- ▶ Not included in DP activities
- ▶ May or may not test
- ▶ Do not get the IB seal on Diploma

▶ Diploma

- ▶ Takes full IB load of classes
- ▶ All benefits of IB
- ▶ Take all tests *
- ▶ IB Medallion and Seal
- ▶ Can get up to a year of college and scholarships

Defining terminology (IB 11th and 12th Only)

▶ Probation

- ▶ A student has had one incident of bad behavior or student has been academically dishonest.
- ▶ Student remains in program PDP or IB as long as there are no more violations.

➤ Dropped

- Student fails an IB course in 11th grade.
- Student remains at Central as a course candidate.
- Student continues in classes that he/she passed and can test to earn college credit.

▶ Removal (Dismissal)

- ▶ Student has had two or more incidents of bad behavior or academic dishonesty.
- ▶ Student will not be in classes at the end of the year.
- ▶ Student if not in Central Zone goes back to home school.

Internal Assessment

- ▶ Failure to complete internal assessment or plagiarism on internal assessment
 - ▶ Dropped as a diploma candidate
 - ▶ Will not get IB medallion or IB seal
 - ▶ Will not take that test and cost of test becomes a student debt- parents must be notified immediately.
 - ▶ Last year almost \$3000.00 was paid for tests that were not taken, failure to complete internal assessments and plagiarism.
 - ▶ All material not turned in resulting in an “N” affects the overall score of the school.

Testing Issues/Dates/Place

- ▶ If a student misses a test, they can not take it later.
- ▶ They will automatically be removed as a DP candidate and fees will be assessed.
- ▶ Only exception is hospitalization.
- ▶ Taylor Auditorium (Wesleyan) and a psychology room will be used for testing.
- ▶ Leave phones in the car. Show up with calculators if needed and a pencil and pen.
